TONY HAWK'S BOARD SELLS FOR \$1.15 MILLION

Tony Hawk's old skateboard now has a new owner. Julien's Auctions sold the Birdhouse "Falcon 2" deck for \$1.15 million, the highest price paid for any skateboard. The auction house said the board was special.

Hawk rode this board at the 1999 X Games in San Francisco. He was 31 years old and wanted to land a new trick.

The trick was called the 900. The rider turns two and a half times in the air before landing on the ramp. Hawk missed many tries that night. He kept calm, tried again, and finally succeeded. The big crowd cheered, and TV announcers shouted with joy.

Before that night, Hawk had already won 73 contests by age 25. He stayed the ramp skating champion for 12 years in a row. Those years were during the 1980s and 1990s.

The sale set a new record for a skateboard. Collectors say the board shows an important part of sports history. Part of the money will help The Skatepark Project, Hawk's nonprofit group. It works with towns to build safe skateparks so young riders can practice.

Fans see the sale as a sign that Tony Hawk still matters. The board reminds people that practice, courage, and community can change a sport.

PANTONE PICKS WHITE FOR 2026 COLOR OF THE YEAR

Pantone, the world's color expert, has chosen its Color of the Year for 2026. The color is white. More exactly, it is a shade of white called Cloud Dancer. Pantone has picked a Color of the Year every year since 1999. The color shows what the company thinks will be popular in the coming year. It also shows the mood of the world.

Pantone says Cloud Dancer brings calm and peaceful feelings. The company says society is finding the value of quiet again. In 2026, this white color will appear on many products, from smartphones to furniture and even Play-Doh.

This is the first time the company has chosen a white color. However, it is not the first time they picked a color to help people feel less stressed. In 2011, the color was Honeysuckle, a pink meant to lift spirits. In 2010, a calm turquoise was chosen. And in 2024, Peach Fuzz was the color to help people care for themselves.

Pantone's Color of the Year can influence fashion, design, and lifestyle trends. People on social media have different feelings about Cloud Dancer. Some are interested, but others are unhappy with the choice.

How does Pantone choose the color? It is mostly a secret. Color experts at Pantone talk all year about design trends. They say the goal is not to push one color but to show how powerful color can be.

Nuts May Cut Craving For Sweets And Fast Food

A new study has found that a daily nut snack may cut cravings for sweets and fast food. It may also help people choose healthier foods.

The journal *Nutrients* published the study on December 2. The researchers followed young adults who had a higher risk of health problems. These problems can include high blood pressure, belly fat, and abnormal cholesterol. They can raise the risk of heart disease and diabetes.

For 16 weeks, the young adults ate mixed tree nuts every day between meals. After the study, they reported fewer urges for sugary and salty snacks. They also wanted fast food less often. They ate more protein-rich foods, and their overall diet improved.

Kezia Joy, a food expert, said nuts have fat, protein, and fiber. These nutrients digest slowly, so blood sugar stays steadier. Many people feel fuller longer, so cravings can drop.

Public health professor Jacqueline A. Vernarelli suggested about a quarter cup of nuts.

Almonds, cashews, walnuts, Brazil nuts, and macadamia nuts are good choices. She said people should choose whole nuts that are raw or dry-roasted. She also recommended unsalted nuts because salted nuts can have a lot of salt.

Allergic to tree nuts? Vernarelli said seeds can be a good option, too. She suggested sunflower seeds and pumpkin seeds. They also have healthy fat, protein, and fiber.

META BLOCKS UNDER-16 ACCOUNTS IN AUSTRALIA

Meta says it blocked about 550,000 accounts in Australia in the first days of a new social media ban for children. The law, which started in December, tells big platforms like Instagram, TikTok, and YouTube to stop people under 16 from having accounts.

Campaigners and the government say the ban is needed to protect children from harmful content and from systems that push certain videos. Similar limits are being tried in other places, but Australia's rule is the strictest and does not allow parents to approve accounts.

Meta says it supports stronger safety but wants a different method. In its first week of following the law, the company said it blocked 330,639 Instagram accounts. It also blocked 173,497 Facebook accounts and 39,916 Threads accounts.

Meta argues that age checks should happen at the app store level, so rules are easier for apps and officials. It also wants an exception so parents can approve their children's accounts.

Meta says this would stop teens from moving to new apps to get around the ban.

The policy is popular with many parents, and some leaders in other countries have praised it. Britain's Conservative Party said it would copy the idea if it wins the next election. However, some experts warn that teenagers may still get past age checks. Also, some young people say the ban could reduce connection and support for teens who already feel isolated.
