Lentil by lentil, Nepali food takes shape in Tokyo

At Nepalico in Shibuya, owner Padam Devkota opened his restaurant in 2010 to share the traditional flavors of rural Nepal. Born in Gorkha, he serves dal bhat, a classic Nepali dish of rice, **lentils**, and vegetables. At first, customers asked for butter chicken and naan, but Devkota explained that dal bhat is healthy and comforting — “slow food” for busy Tokyo life.

Before Nepalico, **authentic** Nepali **cuisine** was rare in Japan. Most Nepali chefs worked in Indian or Indo-Nepali restaurants, serving Indian-style curries because that’s what Japanese people knew. Many Nepalis came to Japan during the 1980s economic boom, filling jobs as cooks when Indian chefs became scarce. Over time, some opened their own restaurants, helping to spread awareness of Nepali food.

Today, new chefs are taking Nepali cuisine in creative directions. For example, Momo Stand in Ebisu serves Nepali dumplings called momo with Japanese ingredients, like miso and dashi, in an omakase style. Along with Nepalico, such restaurants are helping Tokyo diners discover the rich diversity of Nepali cooking beyond Indian curry.
